As an employer we lead by example – 40% of our workforce have a declared disability. Success for us is measured by the positive impact on the lives of those we support and the progress they make, as well as the profit we generate.





LEARNING COACHING & ADVICE

Focussed on people facing barriers and challenges in life, the Learning, Coaching & Advice teams deliver three separate, but linked services in community settings across Suffolk. The key priorities of our services are to provide people with the confidence and skills to make positive life and/or work choices.

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICE

With 30 years' experience of delivering government-funded adult learning opportunities in the community and with the community, we know how to deliver courses that are tailored to meet individual needs.

We offer a wide range of courses from improving English/ Maths/ICT/Vocational skills to supporting children in their learning or improving wellbeing. Many of these courses lead to recognised qualifications.

PEER SUPPORT SERVICE

Our dedicated team members support people with learning disabilities and/or Autism to set up social groups with like-minded people in their own communities.

Participants share their experiences, interests and discuss their future ambitions. Information, Advice and Guidance is provided on topics ranging from budgeting to career and training opportunities.

Poppy's is a bright and airy wholefoods retail unit, which has a farm-shop look. Specialising in ethically sourced products, such as Fairtrade, the shop has a devoted customer following due to its extensive range of vegetarian and vegan products, gluten-free food, dairy-free food, eco-friendly household products and many other special dietary products which are hard to find elsewhere. Every Tuesday, Poppy's Pantry runs a pop-up community café in St Mary's Church Centre, Woodbridge, selling hot and cold drinks, delicious homemade cakes and light lunches.
