Our English courses are designed to support you to develop your skills and confidence in reading, writing and communication skills for you to apply them in employment and everyday life.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Aged 19 or over

WHAT WILL YOU DO ON THIS COURSE?

You will have the opportunity to gain qualifications that can help improve your job prospects and/or lead on to further learning. There are progression pathways for every level of learning.

You will work in small, friendly groups at your own pace and be offered an individual learning programme that is suited to your needs:

- ✓ **Unaccredited** learning (no exams)
- ✓ **Unit qualifications**/Awards/Certificates (portfolio work)
- ✓ **Principles in** English (exams)
- ✓ **Functional Skills** English (exams)

You will take part in a range of activities in small groups or pairs and individual work. You will be expected to attend every week. There will be regular progress checks with opportunities for intervention sessions to practice those skills you need to improve. There will also be home learning to be done between sessions. Please bring with you a pen, pencil and be ready to learn. Some equipment and resources can be provided.
